(Until the end of Week 1 of Lock Down) and

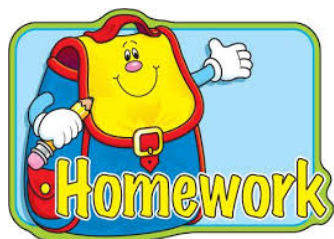
Wednesday 15 March until further notice
