STUDENTS RETURNING TO KURA

We would like to thank you for your prompt response to whaea Phyllis regarding whether or not your child would be returning to Kura at Level 3.

We have a small group of confirmed students of essential working whānau, returning to Kura next Wednesday. Due to the low number, we will have limited staff on-site. All whānau will receive a Health & Safety pānui outlining guidelines of what Kura will look like for those returning.



If your child needs to return to Kura as your return to work is essential, you **MUST** contact whaea Roberta at roberta.kaiwai-paterangi@tkkmom.ac.nz or ring whaea Hana via the Kura phone on 0210586508, at least a day in advance. This will allow time for staff to set up personal learning spaces and inform you of the Health & Safety procedures and expectations. We are following the guidelines in keeping with bubble sizes of 10 per teacher.

- * **Whaea Roberta & Pou Rawinia** will return to Kura on Wednesday 29 April to teach returning students. A safe learning space has been set up in Te Aweawe for all students.

- * **All Teaching Staff** will continue to work remotely from home. As the number of students increase, more staff will return to support on-site learning.

DEVICES & LEARNING PACKS

DEVICES:

We are aware that some whānau have been anxiously awaiting the arrival of digital learning devices whether it be from the Ministry of Education or from Kura.

The names of 30 of our students who indicated that they did not have access to their own digital learning device at home, have been sent to the Ministry. While the vision of the government was to provide all students with a learning device, we must understand that we sit in a priority ranking. Receiving a device will also depend on what devices are available within New Zealand.

Therefore, we acknowledge that having access to a device is paramount to providing continued access to learning remotely from home. We will make all attempts to support access to devices at home.
