NGĀ WĀ WHAKATAKA TAMARIKI, TIKI TAMARIKI ANŌ HOKI

He manatū tēnei e te whānau, ko te painga kē atu ka tae mai ā tātau tamariki ki te kura kai waenga i te 8.30am me te 9am. Heoi me tae mai i mua i te 9am (wā karakia) kia tū takarerewa, kia ū ki ngā mahi, kia tau te wairua. Ko te wā tiki tamariki, ko te 3.30pm. Ki te tōmuri tō taenga mai te tiki tamariki tēnā waea mai ki te tari, tuku pātuhi mai ki tētahi pouako ranei. Kāore he raru ki te whakawhiti kōrero koe ki te kura. I tērā wāhanga o te tau i kaha kōrero ki ētahi mō te taenga tōmuri mai me te kore whakamōhio mai ki a mātau. Kia kaha tātau!

This is a subtle reminder that tamariki are not to be dropped off before 8.30am. Staff are busy and in hui some mornings therefore it becomes a safety issue when tamariki are dropped off early without notification and they're taking care of themselves in places we are not aware of, eg: courts, behind buildings. We do ask however if tamariki could be dropped off (preferaly) in time for whole school karakia which commences at 9am in Te Aweawe this mentally, spiritually and physically helps to prepare them for the day. A reminder also that all pick up's need to happen by 3.30pm daily. However if you are going to be late please make contact with the kura or send a message to a staff member and they will relay this to the duty teacher.
